



QUICK AND EASY VIDEO

Tomorrow you are going to learn how to do a video project with students using a method created by Margo Nanny called "Quick and Easy Video." Today you need to divide yourselves into small groups of from two to four people. Meet with your group and decide on a basic topic or theme for your video and who will bring the following items:

- A video camera
- Video film
- Batteries
- Plugs
- RCA Cables
- Props
- Tape or CD Player
- Audio tapes or CDs for background music
- Costumes

Possible topics for your short, five-minute video are limited only by your imagination. Some ideas include:

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"Quick and Easy Video" is a method you can use with your students to create analog video project. It uses a video camera, cables, a CD or tape player, and VCR and a TV.
